Alexander Rutherford Scholarship

Apply once your official high school transcript marks are available and when you are currently enrolled in full-time post-secondary studies. Value up to \$2500.

To receive this scholarship, you must also meet all of these eligibility criteria:

- be a Canadian Citizen, a Permanent Resident of Canada or Protected Person
- be an Alberta resident
- be enrolled in a full course load in a designated undergraduate post-secondary or an apprenticeship program of at least one semester in length.

Horatio Alger Association of Canada Vocational and Technical Education Scholarship

MindFuel-Scholarships for Young Innovators

- Eligibility: Grade 12 students graduating from an Alberta, Saskatchewan or Manitoba high school, who identify themselves as either: BIPOC; women, two-spirit, transgender, or non-binary; Individuals part of the LGBTQ2S+
- Students must be entering their first year in an undergraduate STEM-related program at an accredited post-secondary institution located in Alberta, Saskatchewan or Manitoba.
- Annual scholarship of up to \$2,500 each, awarded to two recipients as follows: \$1,000 awarded for first-year post-secondary education; \$1,500 for second-year, provided the recipients have maintained an 80% grade average throughout their first year.
